The Hong Kong Association of University Women (HKAUW) is inviting applications for a number of Undergraduate and Postgraduate Scholarship Awards for the year 2009/10. The details of the HKAUW Scholarships are attached. Please submit *no more than two* nominations for Undergraduate Scholarships from your institution but as many for Postgraduate Scholarships as you deem appropriate. All applicants must be nominated by the head of department or faculty/school in which the candidate is currently registered.

For Undergraduate Scholarships, completed application forms (including only relevant information), together with required documents must be received by the HKAUW at the address below by **5:00 p.m. on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2009** via the Student Affairs Office of their institution. Late application will NOT be considered.

For Postgraduate Scholarships, applicants may directly submit their applications to HKAUW or via their institutions. Please note that an applicant for the Postgraduate Scholarship has to be a full member of HKAUW. (See "Join Us" on the HKAUW website at <http://www.hkauw.org/>). Completed scholarship application form, a letter of recommendation from her current supervisor, together with all required documents should be returned to the address below. These must be received by the HKAUW by **5:00 p.m. on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2009**. Late application will NOT be considered.

Undergraduate Scholarship applicants will not be interviewed personally.

HKAUW will notify short-listed Postgraduate Scholarship applicants for interviews by late October. They are required to attend an interview on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2009 (Saturday). Applicants who will not be available for the interview are advised not to apply.

All final recipients of the Undergraduate and Postgraduate Scholarships will be notified directly by HKAUW about the award. The Scholarship Coordinators of the nominating institutions will receive the names of the final scholarship recipients. Applicants who are not notified by mid-December 2009 should consider their applications unsuccessful.

Certificates and cheques will be awarded at a Presentation Ceremony at the HKAUW Christmas Dinner on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2009. Absence from the event will mean forfeiture of the scholarship.
